The Rindge Conservation Commission is holding a presentation for landowners and the interested public on "An Introduction to Improving Wildlife Habitat on Your Land" on Saturday, March 23 at 10:00 a.m. at the Rindge Community Center on Wellington Road. The presentation will be conducted by Matt Tarr, Ph.D., Extension Professor – Wildlife Specialist for the University of New Hampshire Cooperative Extension.
